

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

CORPUS CHRISTI

Welcome to our weekly Parish bulletin!

Following the first communion of eighteen children which happened three weeks ago, fourteen youths received the sacrament of Confirmation Sunday, May 28, the very day of Pentecost. I was overjoyed, for it was the first time this occurred in this parish on my leadership as a pastor. I've been thanking the Lord for such a blessing. And as we move forward, we continue to spiritually assist these young people so that they may continue to implement what Holy Confirmation is about. Our sincere thanks once again go to Very Reverend Fr. William P. Joy, former pastor of Saint Angela and Saint Matthew parishes, who presided this wonderful celebration. Let us keep all our youths and children in our prayers that they may truly be effective part of the Church sharing in Christ's strength and mission!

This current weekend the church celebrates the solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, traditionally known as Corpus Christi, which is another feast of the Holy Eucharist. Actually, the feast of the Eucharist is Holy Thursday when the Lord instituted this sacrament. But on Holy Thursday, we also celebrate the institution of the priesthood, the washing of the disciples' feet, and the agony of Gethsemane. For this reason, the Feast of Corpus Christi was established to create a feast focused especially on the Holy Eucharist. This feast invites us to deepen our faith in the real presence of Christ in the Holy Eucharist. It also makes us concentrate our thoughts and prayers on the impact of the Eucharist on our daily worship and commitments. In the evening of Easter, the disciples of Emmaus recognized Jesus only when he broke the bread before them. Today again many will recognize Jesus in the Church if we break the bread before them as well. That means, if we help those in need, have food, shelter, health care, justice, and so on. Some people may say it is not the church's business. And yet it is. The celebration of the Eucharist invites us to do so. It invites us to witness to the Lord inside and outside the Church so that we can effectively serve God in worship and actions. People who celebrate the Eucharist must make the world a better place.

Happy feast of the Blessed Sacrament!

LA FÊTE-DIEU

LA FÊTE-DIEU, appelée aussi Fête du Saint-Sacrement, Corpus Domini, ou Corpus Christi est une fête religieuse catholique et anglicane, célébrée le jeudi qui suit la Trinité, c'est-à-dire soixante jours après Pâques. Actuellement, le nom officiel de la fête, dans l'Église catholique, est « Solennité du Corps et du Sang du Christ ». Cette fête commémore la présence réelle de Jésus-Christ dans le sacrement de l'Eucharistie, c'est-à-dire sous les espèces du pain et du vin consacrés au cours de la Messe. L'origine de la Fête-Dieu est due à un miracle qui a eu lieu au XIIIe siècle à Bolsena en 1263. Ce miracle est relaté par les fresques de la Cathédrale d'Orvieto. Un prêtre de Bohême, Pierre de Prague, avait fait un pèlerinage et avait de grands doutes spirituels notamment sur la présence du Christ dans l'Eucharistie. Lors d'une messe célébrée par le prêtre, lors de la consécration, l'hostie prit une couleur rosée et des gouttes de sang tombèrent sur le corporal et sur le pavement. Le prêtre interrompit la messe pour porter à la sacristie les saintes espèces. Le Pape Urbain IV vint alors constater ce qui était survenu. Quelque temps après, soit le 8 septembre 1264, le pape Urbain IV institua la Fête-Dieu par la bulle "Transiturus". Il la fixa au jeudi après l'octave de la Pentecôte et confia la rédaction des textes liturgiques à saint Thomas d'Aguin. Celui-ci († 1274) a marqué la pensée catholique par son art de la synthèse, la profondeur de sa réflexion et sa capacité d'exposition pédagogique de la foi. Il se distingua par sa dévotion et son amour de l'Eucharistie qu'il célébrait chaque jour après avoir servi la messe d'un de ses confrères. Quand il célébrait l'Eucharistie, des larmes coulaient sur ses joues. Le Christ lui apparaissait pour lui dire qu'il avait bien parlé de lui au sujet de l'Eucharistie. On a attribué à Saint Thomas d'Aquin la rédaction du Pangelinguaavec le Tantum ergo, le Lauda Sion et tout le reste des pièces liturgiques latines prescrites par la liturgie de la fête.


